



Tangier Model United Nations Annual Conference

Conference Policies

By registering for the Tangier Model United Nations (TMUN), all the delegates abide by the following conference policies.

Terms and Conditions:

Eligibility

All the delegates registering should be current high school students(Grade 9-12). Delegates have to register as an institution and can't apply individually.

Registration and Fees School Registration

All registrations are accepted on a first come first serve basis, once the maximum capacity is attained delegates will be placed on a waitlist and will be notified when vacancies are made. School registration should be submitted before September 23 2019.

Delegate Registration

After filling out the school registration form, the school should complete the delegate registration form. A delegation fee of 950 dhs for chairs and delegates is due with the registration of delegation.

Chaperon Registration (only for non-international schools)

A chaperon fee of 450 dhs for non-international school should be paid along with the registration of the deadline. All schools must have at least one adult moderator present at the conference.

Substantive Policies:

Country Assignment

All the country assignments are done by the MUN Core team, countries are assigned to delegates after they have registered and paid. Country assignments are made on a rolling basis.

Chair Assignment

Chairs are chosen based on the request submitted by students. There is a limited number of chair positions and thus, all the candidates should apply as soon as possible to get the position of a chair in the desired committee.

Ambassador Assignment

Ambassadors are also chosen based on requests, Positions are limited and thus, requests are accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Technology

Use of electronics is permitted during the conference, all the delegates are expected to bring their own electronic device in order to prepare and compile documents. However, the use of cell phones is strictly prohibited throughout the conference and can be used only with the permission of the chairs.

Plagiarism Policy

The entire Secretariat of Tangier Model United Nations is devoted towards a substantial debate and honesty to the conference. Plagiarism is a serious offense to this honesty and to the conference as a whole. Any delegate who are caught plagiarizing before or during the conference will be disqualified from the delegate awards. Any document containing a plagiarized section will be removed. The Secretariat reserves all rights to disqualify a delegate from the awards.

Dress Code

All the delegates are requested to wear western business attire throughout the conference to maintain an environment conducive towards the goal of the conference. Any delegate that violates the dress code will be asked to change their clothes.

Remaining On-Policy

Delegates should keep in mind that they are representing their country and thus, all the statements spoken and written should be in correspondence with their country's position. However, delegates shouldn't be constrained by this rule. Delegates can reach out to their chairs for any questions.

Committee Attendance

Committee attendance is expected of all delegates unless the delegation's moderator has notified us ahead of time. This policy will be enforced by roll call attendance taken at the beginning of each session. Moderators will be notified if any of their delegates are absent from the committee.

Award Policy

Awards are given out in each committee to the best delegates. Best delegates are chosen by the chairs. Delegates are rewarded based on their commitment and participation in the committee; often delegates that are well-spoken and well-researched bag these awards as their participation and enthusiasm keeps the discussion going.
